

ADMISSION TO THE VILNIUS MUSIC SCHOOL "LYRA" P R O C E D U R E

AGE OF PUPILS

1. Primary music education is recommended from the age of seven.
2. For pupils who choose piano, accordion, violin, cello, or flute as their main instrument, it is recommended to start primary education at the age of 8 at the latest.
3. For pupils whose main instrument of choice is other musical instruments (guitar, synthesizer, trumpet, clarinet, saxophone, cancles, birbyna, lambda) or choral singing, it is recommended to start primary education at the age of 8-9, but no later than 10 years.
4. For pupils who have chosen solo singing as their main subject, primary education can start until the age of eleven.
5. It is recommended that children should only start Main Music Education after completing the Primary Music Education program, but not before the age of fourteen.

DATE OF ADOPTION

6. Admission to the school takes place from 1-10 June each year.
If places become available, an additional intake may be announced in September.

REGISTRATION OF APPLICANTS

7. Applicants register **by filling in the "Noriu mokytis" ("I want to learn") application form** on the school's website. Registration is open from 2 May to 31 May.
8. You will receive an email confirmation of your registration and your chosen arrival time at the email address provided in your application.

DOCUMENTS (after acceptance)

9. The following documents must be submitted by 15 June for admission by the Admissions Committee:
 - the child's birth certificate or passport/ID card;
 - passport or ID card of one of the parents/guardians;
 - a grade certificate for music subjects (if the pupil attended another music school).
 - Contract (enrolment of pupils is formalized by a bilateral training contract. The contract covers the obligations of the school and the person, and responsibilities for non-compliance).
10. Failure to submit the above documents by 15 June may result in cancellation of the offer.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

11. An admissions committee (hereinafter referred to as the "Committee") shall be set up by order of the principal and shall be chaired by the principal or his/her deputy for education.
Commission
 - assesses the applicant's artistic abilities during the admission process;
 - the assessment is recorded in the admission report.
12. After checking the artistic abilities of the children and pupils, the Commission may decide to admit them to a higher class in a primary or primary art subject.
13. For admission to music specializations, children are asked **to sing a song, and their musical memory, hearing, sense of rhythm and physical characteristics** are evaluated **to match the chosen core musical subject.**
14. Children and pupils are admitted to the school by order of the Principal. It shall be issued by the Principal on the basis of the minutes of the panel and the documents submitted.

PUBLICATION OF INFORMATION

15. The offer of admission is published on the school notice board and website.
16. The lists of pupils to be admitted shall be published no later than three working days after the end of the work of the admission commission.
